The scope of work for the Howard University parking lot low impact development (LID) retrofit includes site grading, excavation and installation of bio-retention and pervious paver facilities, and stormwater management. The goal of the project was to retrofit the targeted 1.6-acre impervious area with green infrastructure to restore natural hydrology, prevent erosion, reduce stormwater pollution, and protect and restore existing, natural habitat above Soapstone Creek in the Rock Creek Watershed. Triangle Contracting was the bio-retention installation and stormwater management subcontractor on the job under the prime contractor, Biohabitats.
